ARTICLE XII......Class Size....Part A.....TK and K aide time

- \*ALL TK and/or K teachers get a 1.5 hour aide with 14-24 students.
- \*ALL TK and/or K teachers with 25+ students get 1.5 hours more.
- \*Any TK and/or K teacher with NO partner will get 3 hours plus the 1.5 that everyone gets
- \*Any TK and/or K teacher with NO partner <u>MUST</u> give 100 minutes back to the school. This will vary from site to site depending on site needs.
- \*ALL TK and/or K teachers will work 100 minutes in their partner's classroom.
- \* Please feel free to ask....if you have a question on any contract language, chances are someone else does too!

# **WORK FORCE**

You may now view your attendance balance by logging on to the Etiwanda website at <a href="https://www.etiwanda.org">www.etiwanda.org</a>

Click on Employee Resources.....select workforce timekeeping

Enter your SIMS ID # as your user ID AND as your password

Immediately change your password......SIMS # stays the same

Click on "Enter my hours"

A new screen will open to your timesheet (We DON'T use this system to report to work....only classified does)

Select the Bank Balance Tab and Date....this will give you the most current information....DO NOT get docked pay for not using the correct absence selection....you can now keep track yourself on how many sick days and/or personal days you

Don't forget to sign out when you are done.
